

Sweden's Most Exciting New Hotel Openings

Arriving at your destination and checking into a nice hotel is always a nice feeling - especially if you are one of the first guests to stay. Here are some of Sweden's most notable hotel openings, from exclusive boutique hotels to iconic castles and nature-inspired eco-rebuilds.

New 'Tiny Eko House' on the island of Orust, West Sweden

Lådfabriken was once a "Fisklådefabrik" – a fish box factory – but is now a small luxury boutique B&B on the island of Orust, just over an hour north of Gothenburg in the West Sweden archipelago. It's a unique, carefully renovated building with four individually decorated ensuite rooms.

The new 'Tiny Eko House' is a separate building in the garden between the cherry, almond and walnut trees that make you feel as if you're in a tree house. The bedroom is in the loft where, from the kingsize bed, you gaze out across the Skagerrak Sea. On the ground floor, there is a private entrance, a luxurious bathroom and a cosy living room with a ceiling height of 5 meters. All windows face west so you can enjoy sea views and beautiful sunsets. 'Låda' gets its electricity during the summer from solar panels on Lådfabriken's roof. This 'tiny house' was built using a block system, which allows you to build organic and healthy buildings without glue, sealants, or joint foam.

Hello Sunnanhed, Dalarna, Central Sweden

Hello Sunnanhed is a remote private boutique barn, where stillness and reconnection permeate everything they do. If you're looking for a unique luxurious stay in a beautiful, remote location, you'll get that extraordinary experience from the moment you arrive.

Amid Dalarna's stunning landscape lies a historical barn reimagined into a contemporary haven with all the comforts of a nordic design home – and beyond. Instead of reaching for your phone, embrace the present. Take a moment to inhale deeply, feeling the tension release from your shoulders as you stroll through the meadow toward the barn. Observe the weathered wooden exterior and the sturdy door, its slight creak adding to the rustic charm. As you enter in hushed silence, allow your gaze to wander across the bespoke 8-meter-high panelled ceiling and the expansive glass wall that effortlessly slides open with a simple gesture. Feel a wave of serene anticipation wash over you. You've finally arrived. Welcome to Hello Sunnanhed.

The founding principle for the barn redesign was how to honour the 150-year-old structure and gracefully continue the life of the barn, for at least another 100 years. Their ongoing sustainability work continues on their 4 principal practices: leave no trace, MOOPs (materials out of place), local products and stewardship - by 2027 they aim to be net positive in their energy use and, that same year they will have fulfilled their ambition of being a zero-waste establishment as well.

Price: All-inclusive - SEK 25 000 for 2 people per night. This includes - full board + 1 Wild Kitchen experience, full access to the Mini Bar with a well-curated selection of drinks and snacks and 1 x nature experience. A stay of 3 nights is recommended to enable the sense of reconnection to permeate.

Hotel Fratelli, Karlstad, Värmland, Central Sweden

Hotel Fratelli offers an exceptional experience. With 85 rooms, a restaurant, a bar, an orangery and a spa in the center of Karlstad, it will be a hotel for those who want to get away from it all for a while. The name Fratelli, which means "brothers", is an allusion to two of the project's partners, the Olsson brothers, known as restaurateurs in the Värmland region. Open April 22, 2024.

Maryhill Estate, Landskrona, Skåne, South Sweden

The renaming of Örenäs Castle, one of Sweden's most famous estates, is an important step towards rediscovering its origins. In 1867 Judge August Anderberg named it after his wife Mariehild, later it was renamed Maryhill by Countess Wachtmeister. Under the leadership of the [ESS Group](#) and world traveller Robert "Bobbo" Nilsson, Maryhill Estate is set to become an upscale resort.

With 163 rooms and 4 pools, it's not just a castle, it's a bustling destination. Here, guests can enjoy sports such as tennis, pétanque and padel with a sea view. Opening: Summer 2024.

Villa Dahlia, Stockholm - Opens August 29th 2024

This new boutique hotel, which will open in early autumn 2024, offers a personalised experience in an Italian townhouse. Sibling to the renowned [Hotel Diplomat](#) and [Villa Dagmar](#) the conversion of the 1960s building promises 103 guest rooms and suites with breathtaking views of Tegnérunden. Architect Per Öberg was inspired by Milan to design Villa Dahlia, creating an exclusive sanctuary reminiscent of an Italian townhouse. The hotel offers a mix of luxury and cultural appeal, with a restaurant, cocktail bar, spa, gym, pétanque court and chambre séparée.

Clarion Hotel Karlatornet, Gothenburg, West Sweden - Opens September 1st 2024

Karlatornet in Gothenburg is the tallest building in Scandinavia with a height of 246 meters and 74 floors. Luxurious apartments

offer a home away from home, while various restaurants and a sky bar promise culinary delights against the backdrop of the city lights. But that's not the end of the journey. In the fall of 2024, the Clarion Hotel Karlatornet will open its doors. It will add elegance with 300 modern rooms, trendy bars, a stylish brasserie and a luxurious spa.

The ARK, Eriksberg, Blekinge, Southeast Sweden

Eriksberg Vilt & Natur is in Karlshamn, near the Blekinge archipelago. The area is a nature reserve and offers accommodation, gastronomy and an animal enclosure that protects biodiversity. The four-star hotel was named 'Northern Europe's Best Hotel with a Game Reserve' at the 2019 World Luxury Hotel Awards. The new addition, The ARK, is a unique wooden structure over three levels. All 23 rooms have a terrace that offers unobstructed views of the safari park's expansive savannah. The hotel building is close to restaurants, reception, gym and Nature's Spa. The design of the hotel is based on a ship and focuses on maximum sustainability. At The Ark, visitors have the rare opportunity to observe wildlife in their natural habitat from their rooms, fostering a deeper connection with nature without disturbing the animals or their surroundings. Hotel guests can also enjoy the 925-hectare [Safari park](#), exploring alone with their car, or with a guide in a safari car.

Billingehus Skövde, West Sweden - a fully refurbished hotel with new spa on one of West Sweden's table mountains

Hotel Billingehus is on Billingen, one of West Sweden's fifteen table mountains, and part of the [UNESCO Global Geopark](#). The mountain is a mecca for outdoor activities like hiking and mountain biking, lake swimming and both long distance and alpine skiing in the winter. This iconic hotel has perched monument-like on Billingen's slopes for over fifty years, and after a multi-year renovation and a partnership with the renowned architect [Gert Wingårdh](#), has now reopened.

There are 240 rooms, with everything from four poster beds, freestanding bathtubs and even your own sauna, to 70s-style rooms with a gramophone player and disco ball.
