At the same time, 74% of Europeans(3) say they are adapting their travel behaviour to the climate crisis, especially by avoiding extreme temperatures (17%). The Dutch and Germans in particular opt for a so-called "coolcation" – a trip to cooler destinations (4), such as Sweden.
